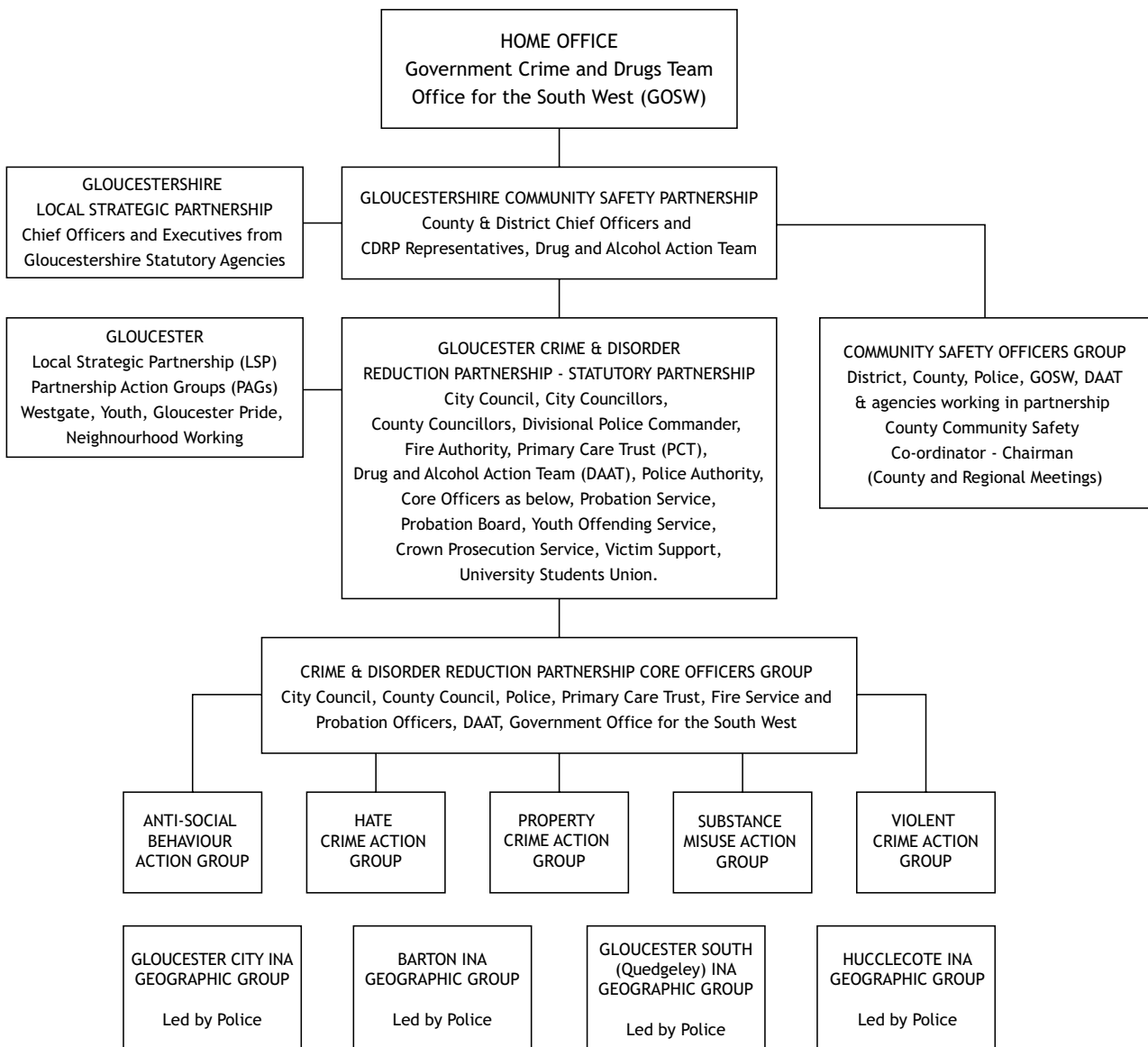


Gloucester Crime and Disorder Reduction Partnership

Partnership working within the city of Gloucester has been established for some time and all partners within the CDRP are committed to making Gloucester a safer place to live. The Partnership comprises a wide array of agencies that meet regularly to discuss problems facing the city, and to seek solutions. The CDRP is the vehicle through which this diverse range of organisations can work together to reduce crime and disorder in a monitored and accountable way. The structure of the Partnership, within the wider arena of community safety in Gloucestershire, is shown below.



The Partnership Core Officers Group meets frequently to discuss and address problems facing the city. The Group guides and monitors the activity of the locally based action teams. These action teams have been established to address specific needs identified in the strategy and are responsible for formulating and implementing the interventions that turn the strategy into action.
